



## Your Rural Address Sign is Your Link to Safety

Posting your rural address in a prominent place ensures emergency responders can find your household quickly – when time is of the essence.

### Where do I post my sign?

- ▶ Post your sign in an obvious place one foot inside your driveway or property line at a 45-90 ° angle ensuring complete visibility from the road
- ▶ Place the sign on the right hand side
- ▶ Attach it to a permanent fixture like a fence or post

### What should my sign look like?

- ▶ Your sign should be a minimum of 1 metre (and no higher than 2.5 metres) above natural ground level
- ▶ Address numbers on your sign should be at least 75 mm (3 inches) in height
- ▶ The reflective panel must be blue and or numbers must be a retro reflective contrasting color (white on blue is recommended)
- ▶ Your sign must be visible at night
