UPDATE- County looks to move forward with Coal Camp Road erosion protection project

Mountain View County has begun efforts to protect County infrastructure along an eroding section of the Coal Camp Road, located southwest of Sundre. County staff have begun working with the engineers and the required agencies to determine the scope of the proposed re-channeling and armouring along the west bank of the Red Deer River. After the engineering assessment is complete, a feasible and effective course of action will be determined. At this time the County will move forward with the required approvals, including a review by Council of the estimated costs, prior to undertaking action necessary to protect County infrastructure.

Mountain View County continues to monitor the affected segment, which is located approximately six miles south of Highway 584 on the Coal Camp Rd (Range Road 6.3).

On Wednesday, Council endorsed two corrective actions brought forward by administration to deal with the eroding river bank situation at the Coal Camp location.
