“Vigilante” comments not representative of Mountain View County, Alberta *Comments by Didsbury resident do not reflect the views of County Council, staff, residents.*

Widely reported comments in the national media by an alleged resident of the town of Didsbury, calling for action from so-called “vigilantes of Mountain View County”, do not reflect the views of Mountain View County residents, its municipal Council, or administration.

While the circumstances surrounding the events in question are very disturbing, Mountain View County, a progressive rural municipality located in the heart of the Calgary– Edmonton corridor, in no way condones the use of vigilante action in this or any other situation.

“Mountain View County supports the provincial and federal justice system, and rejects vigilante action under any circumstances,” says Al Kemmere, Reeve of Mountain View County. “However, we do understand the frustration of citizens who wish to see the process move faster.”
