

**MOUNTAIN VIEW COUNTY BURSARY
OLDS COLLEGE**

Policy Statement:

Mountain View County recognizes the benefits of education for youth, specifically, in the areas of technology, innovation and good farm management practices to ensure the continuance of a strong agricultural base in the future; therefore, the County supports the provision of a bursary to a local student attending Olds College.

Regulations:

1. Applicants must be residents of Mountain View County
2. Applicants must be entering or attending Olds College in an agriculturally-related field, and limited to post-secondary level courses of two years or more, leading to a recognized degree, diploma or certificate in that agriculturally-related field.
3. Applicants must provide a budget and demonstrate financial need.
4. The amount of the bursary shall be \$1,000 per annum.
5. The bursary will be awarded on citizenship, scholastic achievement and financial need.

Procedures:

1. Olds College will advertise the bursary in their scholarship/awards booklet and on campus.
2. The College will review applications, select the recipient based on the County's requirements and contact the County to ensure that the student is a Mountain View County youth.
3. The award will be presented at a regular County Council meeting.
