

RIPARIAN AREA SITE SKETCH

The Site Sketch should include all of the following information in order for it to be considered complete

- Property lines of the parent parcel and any subdivisions
- Location of rivers, creeks, wetlands, dugouts, springs and wells
- Location of existing perimeter fencing and cross fences
- Identify field types - annual (canola, barley, wheat, etc.) perennial (hay) or permanent pasture
- Location of all proposed riparian area fencing (all fencing projects must be wildlife friendly)
- Location of offsite watering systems, waterers or crossings (existing or proposed)
- Describe any vegetation planting proposed (type of grasses, trees or shrubs)

PROJECT AGREEMENT CONDITIONS

Subject to Policy/Procedure #6309 Riparian and Ecological Enhancement Program Funding and Policy #6009 Environmental Protection of Subdivision & Development; the grantee agrees to the conditions below if project funding is approved:

- The grantee will provide Mountain View County (MVC) right of entry on their property for project related visits with prior notice to conduct a Riparian or Rangeland Health Assessment of the project area in funding year and again five (5) years later.
- The grantee will acquire and maintain all required permits, approvals, permissions for the project.
- The grantee will be responsible for the construction and maintenance of the project.
- Fencing projects are required to be wildlife friendly.
- Projects completed on leased land require landowners permission.
- The project detailed on the attached application will be completed by Dec 1 of funding year.
- The grantee will ensure the project remains permanent/functional for a minimum of 5 years.
- MVC will prorate the allocated funding amount based on additional funding received for the project
- MVC will disperse the funds to the grantee upon review of receipts and project inspection
- MVC may post a road-side sign describing the project on the property of the grantee.
- MVC may conduct public tours of the project site with prior approval from the grantee.
- The maximum amount an applicant can receive per voluntary project is \$5000.00.
