Partial Fire Ban

Effective May 03, 2018

Mountain View County has issued a Partial Fire Ban which affects the entire county due to the current and forecasted weather conditions. The Partial Fire Ban is in effect as of May 03, 2018 until further notice.

This requires that all outdoor fires presently burning, be extinguished and the lighting of any outdoor fires is banned.

Open fires; fireworks; recreational fires not contained in an acceptable fire pit; and permit burning fires are prohibited. The only exceptions at this time are acceptable burning barrels; acceptable fire pits; acceptable outdoor fireplaces; barbeques; household fireplaces; and AER flaring.

All current fire permits and fireworks permits are hereby suspended and no new fire/fireworks permits will be issued until the Partial Fire Ban has been lifted.
