## Highway 22 Construction

Near the Town of Sundre

---

### Overview




Figure 1. Alberta Transportation has scheduled the rehabilitation of Highway 22 during the summer of 2021. The project will begin on the West side of the Town of Sundre and will extend 16 km North to Highway 587.

Alberta Transportation has scheduled the rehabilitation of Highway 22 during the summer of 2021. The project will begin on the West side of the Town of Sundre and will extend 16 km North to Highway 587 (see Figure 1, next page)

### Project Details

The project will include approximately 16 km of milling and asphalt paving on Highway 22. Additional improvements include minor intersection repairs, installation of guardrail and high tension cable barrier at select locations, milling rumble strips, and line painting.

Crews will begin on site the week of July 12 with minor grading, barrier removal and signage upgrades. Cold milling and paving operations are scheduled to begin in late July / early August. Construction is anticipated to take approximately 10 weeks to complete, weather permitting. Please note that milling and paving operations will mainly occur between 6:00am and 10:00pm daily until project completion. No work will occur over long weekends.

The project will require gravel extraction from a local gravel source. The prime contractor, Ledcor Group, has selected a Sundre Contracting Ltd. pit on the West side of the Town of Sundre, for gravel extraction and crushing operations.

We ask for local residents patience and understanding as they may notice increased levels of traffic, noise and dust during construction and gravel pit operations.

### Traffic Impacts

As with any construction project, travelers may experience speed reductions, lane closures and minor delays. Signage with additional information on construction timing will be posted on site a week before construction begins. No detours are anticipated. A traffic accommodation strategy is also in place to mitigate the impacts to travelers. This includes additional signage, delineation, and if required, illumination.
