## Highway 584 Construction

### West of the Town of Sundre

#### Overview

Alberta Transportation has scheduled the rehabilitation of Highway 584 during the summer of 2021. The project will begin West of the Town of Sundre and will extend to 8 km East of Highway 734 (see figure 1). The project will include crack repair, paving as well as the installation of high tension cable barrier and milled rumble strips.

In addition to Highway paving operations, Alberta Transportation will also be replacing the bridge structure over Walton Creek on Highway 584.

#### Project Details

##### Highway 584 Construction

The project will include crack repairs and approximately 25.6 km of asphalt paving on Highway 584. Additional improvements include sign replacements, installation of high tension cable barrier

at select locations, milled rumble strips and line painting.

Crews will begin on site the week of June 14 with minor grading, culvert repairs, slope improvements and other minor repairs. Spray patching of cracks is scheduled to begin on June 18. Paving will start after the crack repairs have been completed, likely beginning late June and extend into mid-July, weather permitting.

Please note that milling and paving operations are planned between the hours of 6:00am and 8:00pm daily, until project completion. No work will occur over long weekends.

The project will require gravel extraction from a local gravel source. The prime contractor, Ledcor Group, has selected a Sundre Contracting Ltd. pit on the West side of the Town of Sundre, for gravel extraction and crushing operations.

We ask for local residents patience and understanding as they may notice increased levels of traffic, noise and dust during construction and gravel pit operations.

##### Bridge Construction

Beginning July 2021 construction will also begin on the replacement of the bridge structure over Walton Creek on Highway 584 (see figure 2). Construction will take place between the hours of 7am and 7pm daily. The project is anticipated to be completed mid September, weather permitting.

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### Bridge Construction, continued

The bridge construction will require a two lane detour on site for the duration of the project, with a posted speed limit of 50 km/hr.

### Traffic Impacts

As with any construction project, travelers may experience speed reductions, lane closures and minor delays. Signage with additional information on construction timing will be posted on site a week before construction begins. A traffic accommodation strategy is also in place to mitigate the impacts to travelers. This includes additional signage, delineation, and if required, illumination.
